In Fall 2022, I was a guest lecturer in Communication and Popular Culture (COMM 340) and Research Methods in Communication (COMM 308), two large lecture courses. I prepared a PowerPoint on "Die Hard Fans" that introduced students to fan studies and fan psychology as well as methodological approaches to studying fandoms. I designed and deployed a survey to the students at the start of each class that asked them questions about their own fan identities. This gave me data to fine tune my lecture to their interests in sports, music, and popular media.

I performed Decades Apart over 60 times across the United States including at the Nuyorican Poets Café in New York City, Highways Performance Space in Santa Monica, and the Exit Theater in San Francisco. Other cities: Las Vegas, Los Angeles, Brooklyn, and New Haven. Texas A&M Student Director Marcus Nealy created an excerpt of the show and staged a performance that won the Stratford-upon-Avon Award for Outstanding 10-Minute Play at Texas A&M Corpus Cristi in 2019.
